

LIVE HOMEWORK HELP

Somebody attending West Baton Rouge Schools probably could use some homework help, right? Almost everyone needs some tutoring in one subject or another at some point in their school careers. If you've checked out the cost of hiring a private tutor or attending one of the commercial learning centers in Baton Rouge, you know that getting homework help is going to cost big money and it may not be available to you at a convenient time. So, do you know who provides **LIVE HOMEWORK HELP**? You are correct if you said the WEST BATON ROUGE PARISH LIBRARY. Besides access to an internet-connected computer, the only thing you need to get homework help is a West Baton Rouge Parish Library card, which is FREE if you've never had one. You can also connect to **LIVE HOMEWORK HELP** at the library from 4:00 p.m. until closing, Monday through Saturday.

LIVE HOMEWORK HELP provides tutoring in math, science, English, and social studies for all students, fourth through twelfth grade. Even people taking introductory college courses or pursuing their GEDs can use this online service.

Using **LIVE HOMEWORK HELP** is EASY, EASY, EASY. Here's how you connect to a tutor in an Online Classroom for one-to-one help from your home computer.

Step 1. Have your WBRP library card handy.

Step 2. Connect to the Internet, then log onto www.wbr.lib.la.us

Step 3. Enter your WBRP library card number (the 12 digit number on the back of the card)

Step 4. Enter your grade level and subject.

Step 5. Wait for a tutor to become available (usually only 2 or 3 minutes)

Step 6. Once connected, submit homework question in the text box or on the whiteboard.

Step 7. Finish homework.

Through **LIVE HOMEWORK HELP** you can work with a tutor on specific homework questions as well as get help in understanding subject-specific concepts. You do this through instant text messaging and a real time (instantaneous) white board. If you need help in doing research for a project or paper, the tutors can show you educational web sites. If you have saved a report you've been working on to a computer file, you can share it with a tutor for comments on how to improve it. You can write math questions or type math equations on the white board. It's really awesome.

So, if you need one-on-one help in math (elementary, algebra, geometry, trigonometry and calculus), science (elementary, earth science, biology, chemistry, physics), social studies (American History, World History, Political Science and more) and English (spelling, grammar, essay writing, book reports), get it.
